

## Recycling and Garbage Disposal

Ashworth Square is a community leader in recycling and garbage disposal. All members are encouraged to co-operate to keep our Co-op neat, clean and environmentally friendly.

### RECYCLING

Many disposable items are recyclable at Ashworth: food and beverage cans, glass bottles, most plastics and newspaper. Please consult Mississauga's pamphlets to keep up-to-date on current recyclable material.

North of the highrise, separate containers are situated for newspapers, plastics, cans and glass. Please sort your own material carefully using the appropriate container. Household garbage must not be placed in these special containers.

### HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE

Highrise Put tied garbage bags down the garbage chute. Please do not put newspapers, kitty litter and cardboard down the chute. These items go in the appropriate container or bin outside.

Townhouses An outside compactor for the townhouse members is situated on the north side of the highrise. Place tied garbage bags in the opening. Please do not leave garbage out overnight; dispose of it between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.

It is acceptable to put small cardboard boxes in the hopper for compacting.

### LARGE ITEMS

Leave discarded furniture and other large items in the fenced-in area beside the north driveway. As pickup is on Tuesdays, have items ready on Mondays.

### OTHER GARBAGE

Larger dumpster bins are provided for other garbage such as kitty litter and non-household garbage. When one of these is filled, another is opened. Please use the open bin in which there is sufficient room. Do not overfill and do not leave garbage on the ground. Use the brown bin for large flattened cartons and lawn debris.

Your cooperation is essential. Please dispose of your garbage responsibly, following the guidelines above.
